Refing Responsibilities

Your team will be assigned to referee. Please make sure you are supplying line judges, scorekeeper, flipper and libero tracker .

Match Format

Matches are scheduled for one-hour intervals in pool play. All bracket play is scheduled with one hour and fifteen-minute intervals. All matches will play 2 sets out of 3 - 25 points per set and 15 points in the 3rd set.

Tie Breakers

2 way ties will be decided based on head-to-head results.

There will be no tiebreaking matches; **3 way** ties will be decided in the following order:

- 1.) Win-Loss ratio for the total number of games played in the pool (wins/total games)
- 2.) Point Percentage (a team's total points scored divided by the total points scored by the opponents in that pool)
- 3.) Coin Toss

AWARDS

Each First, Second and Third place teams in all Gold Divisions will receive a team trophy. First, Second and Third place teams in the Gold Division will receive individual medals.
