Warm up Procedures

Warmups for all matches will be a 2-4-4 format, 2 minutes of ball handling, 4 minutes of individual time,

Total number of teams: 30 teams, 2 Divisions: Premier (16) teams and Elite and (14) teams.

Admissions

This year's event will have an admission fee for spectators of \$20 per day or \$35 for a two day. Go to www.buymypass.com for admission tickets. You can purchase tickets at the door. Website www.gamepointevents.com

*Athletes will just need to show their jersey to gain admission to the Gyms.

*Teams will be issued a coaching credential pass for each coach listed on their roster

*Spectators will be able to purchase a colored wrist band at the door each day

Round One Pool Play

Each division will be divided into four pools of four with six rounds of pool play. Four rounds will take place on Friday night beginning at 5:00 pm and two rounds will be played on Saturday morning beginning at 8:00 am.

Round Two Bracket Play

Premier Division - After pool play ends, the first place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Gold Bracket. The second place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Silver Bracket. The third place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Bronze Bracket. The fourth place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Copper Bracket.

Play for all four brackets will consist of 2 semi-final matches and a championship match for the top spot in that bracket. A consolation match for third and fourth place will also be played. Each team will be guaranteed five (5) matches.

Elite Division After pool play ends, the first place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Gold Bracket. The second place team in each pool will advance to a four (4) team Silver Bracket. Three of the third place team in each pool will advance to a three (3) team Pool. 1 third and 2 fourth place team in each pool will advance to a four (3) team Copper Pool.

Play for all four brackets will consist of 2 semi-final matches and a championship match for the top spot in that bracket. A consolation match for third and fourth place will also be played. Each team will be guaranteed five (5) matches.

Refing Responsibilities

Your team will be assigned to referee. Please make sure you are suppling line judges, scorekeeper, flipper and libero tracker .

Match Format

Matches are scheduled for one-hour intervals in pool play. All bracket play is scheduled with one hour and fifteen-minute intervals. All matches will play 2 sets out of 3 - 25 points per set and 15 points in the 3rd set.

Tie Breakers

2 way ties will be decided based on head-to-head results.

There will be no tiebreaking matches; **3 way** ties will be decided in the following order:

- 1.) Win-Loss ratio for the total number of games played in the pool (wins/total games)
- 2.) Point Percentage (a team's total points scored divided by the total points scored by the opponents in that pool)
- 3.) Coin Toss

AWARDS

First and Second place teams in all Gold Divisions will receive a team trophy. First and Second place teams in the Gold Division will receive individual medals.
